### “7 Secrets” on Mt. Unzen

#### Mtn. of marine landmark

Mt. Unzen surrounded by the seas in three sides has the outstanding figure, and visible from all prefectures of Kyushu Island. It was used as the landmark for ancient nation-building in Yoshinogari and Kumamoto.

#### Mtn. with the guardian deity enshrined

Onsen shrine, the religious center of Mt. Unzen, enshrines the guardian deity of Kyushu Island, who is believed to have rescued Japan during Mongol Invasion in medieval times.

#### Mtn. sung in school songs' lyrics beyond the seas

Mt. Unzen is sung in school songs' lyrics in 4 prefectures (Nagasaki, Saga, Fukuoka and Kumamoto) beyond Ariake Sea and Tachibana Bay.

#### Mtn. supporting daily lives of local people

Mt. Unzen helps local fishers on Ariake Sea know the location of vessels, or helps local people forecast weather.

#### Mtn. attracting waves of different cultures

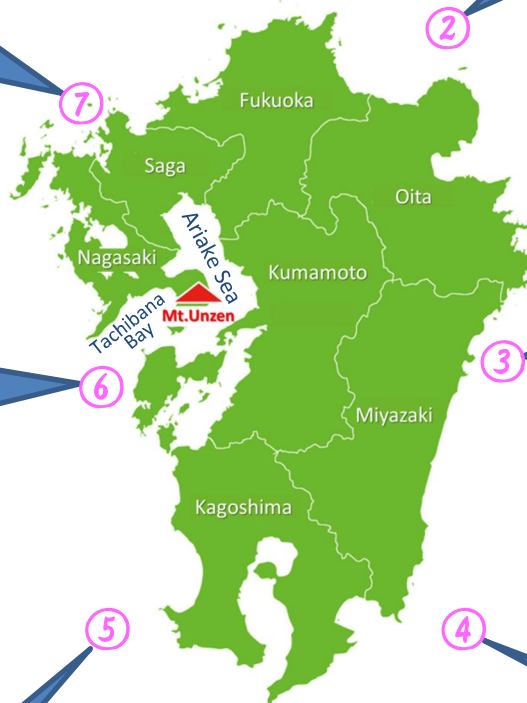
Mt. Unzen was called “Nihonzan” as the landmark for ancient Chinese vessels, and various Chinese or European cultures reached here in earlier timing in Japan.

#### Mtn. having supported industrial revolution

In Miike Coal Mines, with the largest coal output during industrial revolution, the major active carrier was Shimabara Horses pastured around Mt. Unzen.

#### Mtn. maintaining Ariake Tidalflat

Mt. Unzen maintains the mud/sand/silt of the largest tidalflat of Ariake Sea, by narrowing the outlet of the sea.

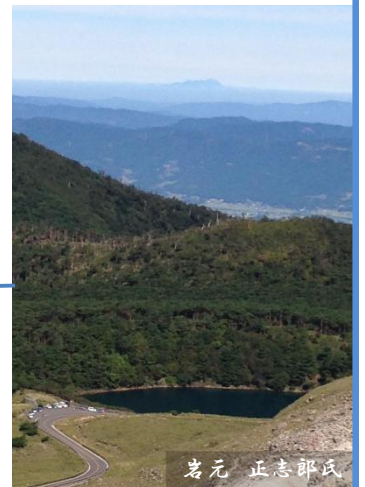
